

Notes:

This versatile piece stands alone as a handbell ensemble presentation, but can also include many different musical groups - handchimes, tuned and untuned percussion, guitar, singers and even your audience. The director may mix and match parts as needed - adding, repeating, doubling, deleting, simplifying, expanding, improvising - to accommodate the available musicians. Prior to the presentation, a quick lesson on the words and signs for the refrain will allow the audience to participate in the fun.

If the Handchime Accompaniment Chords are used, then play the handbell arrangement just on handbells (eliminating the optional handchimes within the arrangement) unless two sets of handchimes are available.

A Handbell Score is also available, code CGB718.
