## **Performance Notes:**

**Christ's Own Body** may be performed in a variety of ways. Options for singing include three alternate endings. At the end of measure 55, an asterisk denotes an optional jump to alternate endings which serve as introductions to three different hymn tunes:

- Measure 60 leads to Vienna;
- Measure 63 leads to Hendon; and
- \* Measure 66 leads to Messiah.

If one of these three tunes is chosen, please note there is included an alternate text which is a corporate version of the beloved hymn "Take My Life and Let It Be".

The piece may end at the last measure of the hymn (plus AMEN, if desired) or, at the beginning of the last measure of the hymn, the accompaniment may shift to measure 55 with the choir singing measures 56-59 as a coda to the hymn.

The final option is for the choir to sing the anthem on its own, complete through measure 59.

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
